The deadline for the competition is 13th September 2010, and completed entry forms must be received by the RITE Administrator before or by the deadline in order to be considered by the judges.

Only one entry per organisation is allowed.

The decision of the judges is final and will not be reconsidered.

The RITE Group reserves the right to amend or change the conference programme/speakers or to cancel or postpone the event at any time.

Winning entries will be notified within two weeks of the competition deadline. The winners will be provided with exhibition space and a delegate ticket for the RITE Group Conference 2010, but will be responsible for their own accommodation and transport costs to and from the venue, as well as the conveyance of their exhibition and display material. Further information about delivery, disposal and storage at the venue will be made at the same time as notification about competition success. The RITE Group will not be able to take responsibility for the clearance of goods through import or export customs.
